#### Day 1 Depart USA

Morning

Depart USA on your night flight to Lisbon, Portugal, via major scheduled international airline. Dinner and Breakfast served aloft as you journey eastward to the Iberian peninsula.

#### Day 2 Lisbon

Afternoon

Arrive at Lisbon International Airport.

Lisbon is the capital and largest city of Portugal with a population of approximately 550,000 with 3 million living in its metropolitan area. With original settlements dating as far back as the 8th century B.C., Lisbon and Portugal underwent Roman and Muslim rule before Portugal finally emerged as an independent state in the 17<sup>th</sup> century. Modern Lisbon is a delightful combination of newer 20th century buildings and older architectural styles dating back to its imperial heyday dominated by white stucco walls and red-tiled roofs with many cobblestone streets still in existence.

Greeting by your highly-qualified **Tour Manager**. The Tour Managers we select are chosen for their high-energy and commitment to customer satisfaction. For the duration of your stay, your Tour Manager will be coordinating and managing all of your scheduled activities and will be available to you on a 24-hour basis should you need special assistance.

Transfer by private air-conditioned motorcoach to your hotel for check-in.

Afternoon

Free time to explore the city's many neighborhoods and explore sights on your own, such as the <u>São Jorge Castle</u>, a Moorish-style fortress with wonderful views overlooking the city, the ruins of the Gothic <u>Carmo Convent</u> mostly destroyed by the 1755 earthquake or the <u>Ajuda Palace</u>, a magnificent neo-classical structure built for the royal family who never occupied it due to their exile to Brazil after the Napoleonic invasions.

Memorial to the Discoveries

Board your private motorcoach for a tour by your English-speaking Guide of Lisbon's modern and historic attractions.

Highlights include the <u>Belém Tower</u>, an intriguing structure originally built as a fortress to guard the entrance to Lisbon's harbor and displaying the distinctively Portuguese <u>Manueline</u> architectural style blending late Gothic with Moorish and even Roman features.

<u>Jerónimos Monastery</u> is a fabulous example of the Manueline style with an abundance of intricate and elaborate architectural details making the complex one of Lisbon's most impressive landmarks.

The <u>Memorial to the Discoveries</u> is an imposing monument to Portugal's glory days of empire known as the **Age of Discovery**.

Other attractions include the **National Coach Museum** with highly-decorated coaches featuring life-size gold-leaf covered wooden carvings dating back to the 18<sup>th</sup> century and the **Alfama**, a medieval-era neighborhood that is a maze of winding streets dotted with churches, small squares and the whitewashed walls of private homes.

Afternoon Transfer back to your Hotel. Lunch on your own.

Free afternoon to explore Lisbon's many walkable neighborhoods for shopping and sightseeing. Look out for attractive handicrafts, such as hand-painted tiles, ceramics, and fine textiles, including tablecloths and fine embroidery.

Start the day visiting the charming village of **Sintra** set amidst wooded rolling hills and featuring the majestic 19<sup>th</sup> century **Pena Palace**, a fairy-tale like castle with a mixture of many different architectural elements typical of the Manueline style.

Continue to <u>Cabo da Roca</u>, the westernmost point in continental Europe for awesome views of the cliffs and Atlantic Ocean, followed by a visit to the charming seaside towns of <u>Cascais</u>, and a drive along the <u>Estoril Coast</u>, stopping to view the <u>Casino Estoril</u> gardens before arriving back in Lisbon.

Roman Aqueduct in Evora Evora's Do Giraldo Square Roman Temple Visit the beautiful town of <u>Évora</u>, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Explore the old town's center. Admire the <u>Roman Temple</u>, the <u>Bones Chapel</u>, the <u>Évora University</u> and the <u>Évora Market</u>, all of them within Évora's medieval walls.

Later visit the village of **Azeitão**, where the local 'Muscatel' wine is produced.

The first stop of your journey is **Óbidos**, 'the medieval city' with its massive wall enveloping the town and hilltop castle affording great views of the surrounding region.

Continue on to Nazaré, a lovely fishing village where you will have an opportunity to explore and have lunch on your own.

In the afternoon, head to the **Mosteiro Santa Maria da Vitória**, best known as **Batalha** Monastery, a Gothic masterpiece, which UNESCO designated a World Heritage Site in 1986.

Final stop prior to arriving in Coimbra, is the village of **Fátima**, world-famous for reported sightings of the "Virgin of the Rosary" in 1917. Visit the **Chapel of Apparitions** and the tombstones of Lucia, Jacinta and Francisco, the three children who were the "seers".

Known as the educational centre of Portugal, <u>Coimbra</u> is also a very attractive community, full of medieval churches and architectural beauty. Highlights of the tour are the <u>University of Coimbra</u>, the "<u>New Cathedral</u>", "<u>Old Cathedral</u>", and the <u>Mosteiro da Santa Cruz</u>.

Day 9 <u>Coimbra – Porto</u>

Morning Breakfast at Hotel and check out.

Transfer to the city of **Porto** (2 hours).

Porto is Portugal's second-largest city with a population of 235,000 and 1.7 million in the metro area. Once an Roman outpost, its lovely Old Town is located on the banks of the Douro River and was registered as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1996. One of Portugal's most famous products, Port wine, was named after this city.

Start your tour in the heart of the city, walking around one of Porto's oldest districts, "Bairro da Sé". Admire the colossal Cathedral built in the 12<sup>th</sup> century and discover all the architectural treasures the city has to offer.

Highlights of the tour are the elegant <u>Aliados Avenue</u>, the <u>Camara Municipal</u> (Town Hall), and **Praça da Batalha**, one of Porto's main squares.

Later visit the **Vila Nova de Gaia**, where the world famous Port wine is produced.
