Day 1 <u>USA – FLIGHTS</u>

Fly overnight to Buenos Aires via major international scheduled airline with likely change of plane enroute. Dinner and breakfast served aloft.

Day 2 BUENOS AIRES

Morning Arrive at Buenos Aires' Ezeiza International Airport.

Greeting by your highly qualified **Tour Manager**. The Tour Managers we select are chosen for their high-energy and commitment to customer satisfaction. Morning Recoleta Walking Tour



Recoleta is Buenos Aires' most elegant and traditional neighborhoood and home to some of the city's most popular sights, including the **<u>Recoleta Cemetery</u>** with opulent mausoleums, where "Evita" Perón is buried, and the **<u>Basilica Nuestra Señora del Pilar</u>**, one of Buenos Aires' oldest churches dating back to Spanish colonial times.

Visit "<u>The Flower</u>", a 7-foot high steel and aluminum structure with "petals" that open in the morning to 106 ft. in width and close at night to 86 feet wide, symbolizing a "hope reborn every day at opening".

Afternoon Check in to your Three-Star Hotel.

Morning & City Sightseeing Tour

Tour with an overview of Buenos Aires' culture and history as seen through its neighborhoods and historical landmarks.

Highlights include the **Plaza de Mayo** featuring the **Casa Rosada** Presidential Palace, **Cabildo** 17th-century town hall, and **Metropolitan Cathedral**. Continue on to the **Palace of Congress**, the world-class **Teatro Colón** opera house, **Avenida Nueve de Julio**, the city's main avenue at 12 lanes wide, and the **Obelisk** (reminiscent of the Washington Monument).

Puerto Madero's **Women's Bridge** and the **Palermo** parks district with wide boulevards, leafy parks, and extravagant monuments round out your introduction to this great city.

Stop for an included **Lunch** during your city tour.

<u>La Boca Neighborhood</u>



La Boca is a colorful and historic neighborhood of Buenos Aires. located on the city's south side.

The port of La Boca was the point of entry for many immigrants to Argentina with an especially large number arriving from Genoa, Italy in the late 19th century. Communal homes, known as "conventillos", sprang up with many painted in colorful hues, said to be using paint left over from the painting of ship's hulls.

Visit the famous "<u>Camino</u>" pedestrian street where artists display their works and street performers dance the tango

Boca is best-known as home to the **<u>Club Atletico Boca Juniors</u>**, one of the world's most storied soccer clubs, and its classic stadium "<u>La Bombonera</u>" which is available for visits.

Evening Tango Dinner Show & Lessons (optional - approx. US\$ 55)



Enjoy one of Buenos Aires' cozy and elegant dinner theatres, reminiscent of the early 20th century. Dine on delicious Argentine beef or other delicacy as you are entertained by perfectly-groomed and fashionably-attired Tango dancers performing the traditional dance with its distinctive dramatic movements. A wonderful musical experience !

<u> "Pampas" Ranch Day – Full-Day</u>



Depart in your private motorcoach for an exciting visit to an authentic Argentine "estancia" (cattle ranch). Highlight of your visit is a traditional Argentine "asado" (barbecue) featuring delicious cuts of world-famous Argentine beef grilled over an open pit. **Barbecue Lunch** is included.

<u>Museo Nacional de Arte Decorativo</u> – This former mansion of Buenos Aires' early 20th century elite is a wonderful place to visit featuring its own café for a relaxing break.

<u>Museo de Arte Latinoamericano de Buenos Aires</u> (MALBA) – This museum is Buenos Aires' most acclaimed and popular museum with its modern architecture and extensive collection of mostly modern Latin American Art.

<u>Museo de Bellas Artes</u> - Featuring fine European and Argentine art, much of it depicting historical events which shaped modern Argentina.

Visit this market in the traditional neighborhood of Recoleta for lots of bargains on hand-made leather, jewelry, and decorative items at the hundreds of stalls staffed by the artisans themselves.

San Telmo Flea Market (Sundays Only)



San Telmo is said to be the location of the first settlement of Buenos Aires in the 17th-century in what is present-day Parque Lezema.

The neighborhood still consists primarily of low-rise colonial-style buildings featuring lively restaurants, shops filled with intriguing antiques, and dancers performing traditional tango on San Telmo's cobblestone streets.

Plaza Dorrego is the center of San Telmo's Sunday market, which features artisans and antique dealers selling their wares from sidewalk stalls stretching various city blocks.
