Day 1 <u>USA – ZAGREB</u>

Fly overnight to Zagreb via major international scheduled airline. Change of plane enroute. Dinner and breakfast served aloft.

Day 2 ZAGREB – SPLIT

Morning Arrive at Zagreb's International Airport.

Transfer by private motorcoach to the city of **Split** where you will check in to your Hotel.

Day 3 SPLIT - TROGIR

Morning Breakfast at Hotel.

Proceed to nearby **Trogir**, for a tour of this city.

Trogir is a picturesque town of about 13,000 people located on a small island between the Croatian mainland and the island of Ciovo lying about 15 miles west of the larger city of Split. Dating back some 2,300 years, Trogir was founded by Greek colonists and was later ruled by other powers, including Venice. The town has a large number of palaces, churches, and towers and its historic city center was added to the UNESCO World Heritage List in 1997.

Kamerlengo Castle

Trogir is known for its many examples of **Romanesque-Gothic** architecture. View Trogir's harbor and visit the town's historic center featuring numerous Romanesque churches and important buildings from the 13th century. The **city gate**, **city walls**, **Fortress Kamerlengo** and the **Church of St. Lawrence** are among the most notable attractions of the town.

Afternoon Transfer back to **Split**, the largest city of the **Dalmatia** region of Croatia, for a city tour.

Split has a population of about 220,000 and is located on a peninsula on the shores of the Adriatic Sea. The city was founded by Greeks about 2,600 years ago and was later ruled by Romans, became part of the Kingdom of Yugoslavia, the Socialist Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and gained independence (for the second time) as part of the Republic of Croatia in 1991.

Today, Split is an important tourist destination with a historic city center and active cultural life with several museums and its own university.

Enter Split's historic center dominated by the massive 4th-century <u>Diocletian's Palace</u> built by the Roman emperor of the same name. With it walls measuring some 570 to 700 feet long and 50 to 70 feet high, the palace resembles a Roman military fortress of the time. The <u>Cathedral of St. Duje</u> and the <u>Riva Promenade</u> are important attractions. A beautiful panoramic view of the city is available from <u>Marjan Hill</u>, one of Split's outdoor recreational areas.

Arrive in the city of **Zadar** and check in to your Hotel.

Zadar, located on the Adriatic Sea, is a city of 90,000 people dating back to the 9th century B.C. when it was founded by the Liburnians. It changed hands many times over the centuries, being ruled by the Romans and Byzantine Empire among others.

St. Donatus' Church

Zadar has many significant landmarks, among them the **Roman Forum**, the pre-Romanesque **St. Donatus' Church** dating back to the 9th century, and several Romanesque churches, chief among them being **St. Anastasia's Cathedral**. Roman ruins in the form of marble columns, fortifications, and parts of an aqueduct can still be seen.
