Day 1 USA – AUCKLAND

Afternoon Fly to Auckland via major international scheduled airline with possible change of plane enroute. Dinner and breakfast served aloft.

Day 3 AUCKLAND

Morning Arrive at Auckland International Airport.

Transfer to your Accommodation.

Morning Auckland City Tour

Cross the **<u>Harbour Bridge</u>** to the summit of <u>**Mount Eden**</u>, a dormant volcano that offers great views of the surrounding city and waterways all the way to <u>**Rangitoto Island**</u> at the entrance to <u>**Waitemata Harbour**</u>. Visit the Auckland Domain, the city's oldest park located on a 62,000 year old volcano, continuing on to <u>**Parnell Village**</u> with historic buildings that have been converted into boutiques, antique shops, and specialty stores. Travel along the scenic waterfront on <u>**Tamaki Drive**</u> to conclude your tour before returning downtown.

Rangitoto Island Tour



This morning you will catch a ferry over to Rangitoto Island and journey to the summit of a dormant 7,000 year old volcano for amazing 360-degree views including the volcanic cone. Return by ferry to Auckland.

Day 5 <u>AUCKLAND</u>

Morning Waiwera Thermal Pools

This morning you will travel by bus, 30 miles north to the coastal village of Waiwera, which is an indigenous Maori name meaning "Warm Waters". There is a series of hot pools and water slides, which you will be able to relax in, that are heated by volcanic thermal activity.

Day 6 **AUCKLAND – TAUPO**

Morning Breakfast included in tour program and check out from your accommodation.

Waitomo Glowworm Caves Morning

This morning you will transfer by bus from Auckland to Taupo. Along the way visit Waitomo Glowworm Caves for a guided tour through the caves which finishes with a short boat trip through the glowworm grotto. The world-famous Waitomo Glowworm Caves are one of New Zealand's most celebrated tourist attractions. Find out about their colorful history and the tiny glow worms that have made the name synonymous with the region.

Tongariro National Park Afternoon



Travelling on, you will visit the Tongariro National Park. This area is listed as a World Heritage Site for its natural landscape values. The three cone-shaped volcanoes of Mt. Tongariro, Mt. Ruapehu and Mt. Ngauruhoe are a distinct feature in a remarkable backdrop of natural beauty. The trilogy of "Lord of the Rings" was filmed throughout the national park.

Check in to your accommodation.

With the powerful beauty of the volcanic landscape and being set on the shores of Lake Taupo, Taupo is one of New Zealand's most beautiful centers.

Day 8 <u>TAUPO – ROTORUA</u>

Transfer to Rotorua by private motorcoach. On the way you will visit:

Morning Whakarewarewa Thermal Reserve



This morning you will visit Rotorua's largest thermal reserve called "Whakarewarewa". Here you can see a spectacular geyser called "Pohutu" erupt, shooting hot water more than 20 feet into the air!

Visit to Whaka Thermal Village & Maori Concert

Later you will visit the **Whaka Thermal Village**, where you will experience a **Maori concert** and be taken on a guided tour of the village. Take part in cooking your own Hangi Feast for lunch. Hangi simply means, "Food cooked in the ground or an earth oven". **Lunch is included in this activity.**

Afternoon Check in to your accommodation.

Rotorua is located on the shores of Lake Rotorua and is 280 meters above sea level. There is more thermal activity in Rotorua than anywhere else in New Zealand. It has hot thermal springs, gushing geysers and bubbling mud pools. Rotorua is also a great place to experience Maori culture (Maori's are New Zealand's indigenous people).

Morning Paddle a Waka (Traditional Maori 16-berth Canoe)

You will be taught by your Maori instructor the traditional methods of paddling a "Waka" canoe.

AfternoonFree afternoon to explore Rotorua. There are many options for exciting activities:
(All of the below activities are optional extra's)

- Visit the Polynesian Spa. Take a swim in the thermal pools. People have been swimming in these waters since the late 1800's, for the alleged health-giving properties of the water.
- Go Zorbing. Climb into an inflated sphere and roll 150 meters down a hill!
- White Water Rafting. Grade 3 4 white water down the Rangitaiki River.
- White Water Sledging. Zoom down the Rangitaiki River on a specially designed sledge!

Visit "Hot Water Beach"

We will visit **<u>Cathedral Cove</u>** at <u>**Hahei**</u> which is like a scene from "Blue Lagoon" and then travel to "Hot Water Beach". This is where hot thermal springs bubble up through the sand and you will dig a hole in the sand and bathe in the hot water!

Drive to Auckland and check into Auckland accommodation.

Free day to explore Auckland and do that last minute shopping.
