Day 1 <u>USA – FLIGHTS</u>

Evening Depart USA on your overnight flight to Amsterdam. Possible change of plane enroute. Dinner and breakfast served aloft.

Day 2 <u>AMSTERDAM</u>

Morning Arrive at Amsterdam's Schipol Airport late morning.

- Dam Square The heart of Amsterdam where the city's original settlement was located and today a hub of activity with people-watching from the local pubs and restaurants being a favorite pastime.
- Royal Palace (optional approx. US\$ 12) Visit the imposing palace overlooking Dam Square, one of four palaces of the Dutch Royal Family. View its fabulous paintings, sculptures and ornate furnishings.

Day 4 AMSTERDAM

Afternoon Anne Frank House

Visit Amsterdam's most compelling attraction, the **Anne Frank House**, home of the young Jewish girl who kept the famous diary during World War II while she and her family were hidden from the Germans.



Rijksmuseum (optional - approx. US\$ 22)

Visit Holland's most important art museum featuring a variety of works highlighted by many famous and recognizable paintings by the Dutch Masters, including the museum's signature piece <u>*Nightwatch*</u> (1650) by Rembrandt.

Van Gogh Museum (optional - approx. US\$ 22)

This museum is almost exclusively dedicated to works by one of the world's most renowned painters, Vincent Van Gogh. Its displays consist of 200 paintings and 500 drawings by Van Gogh and other famous painters of the 19th century, including Gauguin, Monet, and Toulouse-Lautrec.

Morning Muiderslot Castle

Visit this castle in the small quiet town of **Muiden**, some 10 miles east of Amsterdam. The **Muiderslot** dates back to 1280 and was the first in Holland to feature round turrets, which was a French innovation. Add the moat and lovely gardens and Muiderslot is exactly what you imagine a European castle should look like.

The Hague Free Time

- <u>Binnenhof & Ridderzaal</u> (Inner Court & Hall of the Knights) Take a pleasant and revealing walk through this courtyard surrounded by a complex of buildings that includes the Office of the Prime Minister of the Netherlands and the 13th-century Gothic-style Ridderzaal at its center.
- **<u>Peace Palace</u>** View the magnificent home of the International Court of Justice built between 1907 and 1913 in the Neo-Renaissance style.
- <u>The Hague Tower</u> (optional approx. US\$12) Ascend to the 42nd floor observation deck to the highest public viewpoint in Holland for panoramic views of the North Sea, Rotterdam, and as far away as Amsterdam.
- **Skyview De Pier** (optional approx. US\$ 12) Ride this enormous ferris wheel on the Scheveningen Beach for fabulous views of the coast four times around in 20 minutes.
