#### Day 1 <u>USA – FLIGHTS</u>

Evening Depart USA on your overnight flight to Amsterdam. Possible change of plane enroute. Dinner and breakfast served aloft.

#### Day 2 AMSTERDAM - ROTTERDAM

Morning Arrive at Amsterdam's Schipol Airport late morning.

Greeting by your highly-qualified **Tour Manager**. The Tour Managers we select are chosen for their high-energy and commitment to customer satisfaction. For the duration of your stay, your Tour Manager will be coordinating and managing all of your scheduled activities and will be available to you on a 24-hour basis should you need special assistance.

Transfer by private motorcoach to Rotterdam.

Holland's history blends a fascinating tale of commerce and culture. The nation was a wealthy and powerful seafaring and trading empire in its 17th century heyday. This was complemented by its great artistic heritage featuring such famous names as Rembrandt and Van Gogh. Modern Holland has 16 million people and is still an influential and economically-significant player on the world stage.

#### Afternoon **PRACTICE SESSION** at an astroturf field to warm up for the next few days.

Free time to explore **Rotterdam**, Netherlands' second-largest city and one of the world's largest ports. Rotterdam features many notable skyscrapers and structures of unique and innovative modern designs constructed in the aftermath of the destruction of much of the city by German bombers during World War II.

Enjoy a **<u>Boat Tour</u>** of Amsterdam's canals starting from the <u>**Centraal Station**</u> where you will radiate out past many of the city's engaging attractions and charming neighborhoods.

#### Afternoon Anne Frank House

Visit Amsterdam's most compelling attraction, the **Anne Frank House**, home of the young Jewish girl who kept the famous diary during World War II while she and her family were hidden from the Germans.



#### Afternoon **<u>Rijksmuseum</u>** (optional - approx. US\$ 22)

Visit Holland's most important art museum featuring a variety of works highlighted by many famous and recognizable paintings by the Dutch Masters, including the museum's signature piece *Nightwatch* (1650) by Rembrandt.

Van Gogh Museum (optional - approx. US\$ 22)

This museum is almost exclusively dedicated to works by one of the world's most renowned painters, Vincent Van Gogh. Its displays consist of 200 paintings and 500 drawings by Van Gogh and other famous painters of the 19th century, including Gauguin, Monet, and Toulouse-Lautrec.



#### <u> Kinderdijk Windmills & Gouda - Half-Day Tour</u>



Transfer by private motorcoach to one of the most famous Dutch tourist sites, the <u>Kinderdijk</u> <u>Windmills</u>, dating back to the 18th-century and a **UNESCO World Heritage Site** since 1997. This collection of 19 windmills is the largest concentration of old windmills in the Netherlands. Later, visit the city of **Gouda**. The town's central location made it an important trading center with many statues, monuments, and stately homes built by merchants as testimony to its significant past.

Gouda has a worldwide reputation thanks to its **Gouda cheese**. In summertime you can see the traditional cheese market in full swing, on the market square between the "Waag" (weigh house) and the gothic-era **<u>Stadhuis</u>** (Town Hall) dating back to 1450. The latter is one of the oldest gothic city halls in Holland and is definitely worth a picture or two.

Utrecht, the **Netherlands' fourth largest city** with a population of 300,000, has been the religious center of the country since the eighth century with both catholic and protestant church leadership having an important presence. Utrecht University is Holland's largest university.

Utrecht's city center dates back over 1000 years with many of its buildings and structures being from the early Middle Ages, the most prominent of which is the **Dom Tower**, part of the Dom Church, rising up some 370 feet over neighboring streets and buildings.

Utrecht is also home to one of the early landmarks of modern architecture, the 1924 **<u>Rietveld Schröder House</u>**, which is on UNESCO's list of world heritage sites.
