Day 1 <u>USA – MADRID</u>

Evening Fly overnight to Madrid via major international scheduled airline with possible change of plane enroute. Dinner and Breakfast served aloft as you journey eastward to the Iberian peninsula.

Day 2 <u>MADRID</u>

Morning Arrive at Madrid's Barajas International Airport.

For the duration of your stay, your Tour Manager will be coordinating and managing all of your scheduled activities and will be available to you on a 24-hour basis should you need special assistance.

Madrid is the political, economic, and cultural capital of Spain and the country's largest city with approximately 3.3 million inhabitants. The city was once the seat of the Spanish Empire which ranged to the Americas and even as far away as the Philippines. Its royal past and present is evident in many of the city's historical attractions today.

	Enjoy a guided tour of Madrid for an overview of this wonderful city's most important sights.
	View the Royal Palace and the Puerta del Sol square in the heart of the city plus the nearby Plaza Mayor . The Gran Vía with many shops and restaurants is Madrid's main boulevard.
	Plaza de la Cibeles and the surrounding area is most evocative of the glory of Madrid's imperial days with the Puerta de Alcalá and its triumphal archways a head-turning landmark.
	Also view some of the world's greatest art museums, including <u>El Prado</u> , with a fabulous collection of Spanish and European art, plus the <u>Centro de Arte Reina Sofía</u> , featuring modern Spanish art, and the <u>Thyssen-Bornemisza Museum</u> . A short distance away is <u>Parque El Retiro</u> , one of Madrid's most popular spots to relax and wile away an afternoon.

Visit one of the world's premier art museums. Approximately 1,300 of El Prado's 20,000+ works are available for viewing (the rest are in storage or on loan to other museums). Many of the best-known pieces of Spain's and Europe's most famous artists, such as **El Greco**, **Diego Velázquez**, and **Francisco Goya** are displayed here, often with entire rooms dedicated to one artist.

One hour away from Madrid, the walled-city of **Toledo** perched high on a hill overlooking the **<u>Río Tajo</u>** is like an open air museum that holds some of Spain's most important landmarks.

Highlights of the tour are the Muslim-era **<u>Alcázar</u>** prominently overlooking the city, the Catedral de Toledo and the "El Greco Trail", which is a series of landmarks containing El Greco works, including the Museo de El Greco and Iglesia de Santo Tomé, which features the artist's masterpiece, El Entierro del Conde de Orgaz.

Also visit the Jewish Quarter, the Sinagoga del Transito and the Museo Sefardi, for a glimpse into the history of Jewish culture in Spain.

Enjoy lunch on your own in a café on **Plaza de Zocodover**, a favorite gathering place for people-watching.

Royal Palace

Visit this marvelous palace, a massive Italianate structure built in the 18th century with 2,800 rooms, fifty of the most important ones being included in the official tour. These include the main stairway, the Throne Room, the Salon de Gasparini with a beautiful stucco ceiling and silk-covered walls, plus the **Royal Pharmacy** and **Royal Armory**, complete with a collection of 16th and 17th-century weapons and armor.

Transfer to the Roman city of **Segovia**, with its outstanding 1st-century **Roman Aqueduct**. Visit the **Alcázar** Islamic-era castle that looks like it came out of a fairy tale complete with Rapunzel towers topped with witches' hats. Also stop at the Gothic-style **Cathedral**.

The fortified city of **Ávila** is surrounded by a very well-preserved medieval wall, which is 1.5 miles long featuring 88 round defensive towers with battlements at the top that appear like something out of a Hollywood movie. Visit the 12th-century **Cathedral**, the Romanesque **Basilica of San Vicente**, the **main square** and the **Convent of Santa Teresa**, a saint who was native to Ávila.

Day 8 EL ESCORIAL

Morning El Escorial Monastery – Half-Day Tour



The imposing larger-than-life **Escorial Royal Monastery** (officially named the Real Monasterio de San Lorenzo) is widely considered one of the eighth "wonders of the world". This complex, constructed in the 16th century, used to serve as the home of the **Spanish Royal Family**. Visit the **Palace**, the **Monastery**, and the **Basilica**, where many of the Spanish kings are buried.

Afternoon Free time in Madrid. Last opportunity to continue exploring the city, shop for souvenirs, or relax before tonight's concert.
