

# **CHILE & ARGENTINA SPORTS TOUR**

Santiago & Buenos Aires 11 Day / 8 Night Program

#### **SUGGESTED PROGRAM**

**PLEASE NOTE**: Actual sequence and timing of activities will revolve around your game & practice schedule, which will be finalized in the weeks prior to your team's arrival in South America. All times are approximate and may vary according to flight schedules.

#### ALL SPORTS ACTIVITIES ARE HIGHLIGHTED IN RED.

#### Day 1 **USA – FLIGHTS**

Fly overnight to Santiago via major international scheduled airline. Likely change of plane enroute.

#### Day 2 **SANTIAGO**

Morning

Arrive at Santiago's Arturo Benitez' International Airport.

Greeting by your highly-qualified **Tour Manager**. The Tour Managers we use are selected for their high-energy and commitment to customer satisfaction. For the next week, your Tour Manager will be coordinating and managing all of your scheduled activities and will be available to you on a 24-hour basis should you need special assistance.

Santiago, the capital of Chile, is a large, modern city with some 5 million inhabitants, Founded in 1541, at the southern end of the Spanish colonial empire on the Pacific Ocean, the city grew in importance after what is modern-day Chile declared independence from Spain in 1810.

Check into your Three-Star Hotel.

#### Afternoon **City Sightseeing Tour**







Your tour giving you an overview of Santiago starts at the <u>Club Hípico</u> racing track in the traditional <u>West Side</u> residential part of town, featuring the French Art Nouveau / Beaux Arts style of architecture popular in the early 20th century. Proceed to the <u>Cousino Palace</u>, an older mansion that has been refurbished for use as a government VIP residence.

Reaching <u>Alameda Avenue</u> in the heart of Santiago, pass by <u>La Moneda</u> Presidential Palace and numerous statues of independence heroes, into the business and government center of the city. Stop at the <u>Pre-Columbian Art Museum</u>, one of the most complete collections of ceramics, ancient textiles, and other relics of the local indigenous culture.

Arrive at the <u>Plaza de Armas</u> main square where the <u>Metropolitan Cathedral</u> and <u>National Museum</u> are located before proceeding to the <u>San Francisco Church</u> and the <u>National Library</u>, eventually arriving at the <u>Santa Lucia Hill</u> where Santiago was founded in 1541.

Crossing the <u>Mapocho River</u>, ascend the <u>San Cristóbal Hill</u> on the north side of the city for a beautiful panoramic view of the capital below with the Andes in the background. Descending the hill, drive back along the Mapocho River, nearing the foothills of the Andes, and enter the modern, prosperous neighborhoods of <u>Vitacura</u>, <u>Las Condes</u>, and <u>Santa María de</u> <u>Manquehue</u>, with nice homes, manicured gardens, and modern shopping malls. The shopping district of <u>Providencia</u>, with many boutiques, restaurants and cafés, is the final area we visit prior to arriving at your hotel.

#### Day 3 <u>SANTIAGO</u>

Morning Breakfast at Hotel

Morning & Afternoon

Free Day to explore the different attractions Santiago has to offer on your own. **Suggestions:** 

<u>Museum of Memory & Human Rights</u> - Visit one of the city's most popular attractions to learn about Chile's recent history and have an insight on the suffering of the Pinochet years, the military dictator from the 70's and 80's.

<u>Pre-Columbian Art Museum</u> - Housed in the colonial-era customs house, this museum has a very rich collection of pre-Columbian artefacts from Central American and the Andean region.

**National Museum of Natural History** - This institution, which opened in 1830, houses exhibits on zoology, botany, anthropology, and archaeology.

<u>Colonial Art Museum of the San Francisco Church</u> - This church is the oldest structure standing in Santiago, dating back to 1572, and holds the remains of the "Conquistadors". The convent next door has an interesting collection of colonial-era religious art.

### Day 4 <u>VIÑA DEL MAR & VALPARAÍSO</u>

Morning Breakfast at Hotel.

Morning & Afternoon

Viña del Mar & Valparaíso — Full-Day Tour







Board your private motorcoach for a day trip to visit these two charming Chilean coastal communities, located about 75 miles from Santiago. Crossing the coastal range of mountains through various tunnels and traversing the **Curacavi farming valley**, you travel down a hill where you get a wonderful view of both Viña del Mar and Valparaíso, simultaneously.

Entering <u>Viña del Mar</u>, Chile's main beach resort with 300,000 inhabitants, pass the <u>Quinta</u> <u>Vergara</u> museum, the <u>Plaza Vergara</u> (main square), and cross the <u>Marga Marga Canal</u>, where you will make a short stop at the <u>Fonck Museum</u>, featuring artefacts from Easter Island.

Continue to the fishing village of **Con-Con** with its beautiful sandy beaches and rocky coast. Return to Viña del Mar for lunch. (included in tour program)

After lunch, proceed to <u>Valparaíso</u>, a major port where many cruise ships call. The city is divided into two main sections, the coastal settlement and the hillside neighborhoods further from the sea with charming brightly-colored homes perched on the hills. These are accessed by funiculars (hillside elevators) that have a quaint appearance. Passing the <u>National Congress</u>, we go up the <u>Bellavista Hill</u> to see "<u>La Sebastiana</u>", home to the late Pablo Neruda, Nobel Prize-winning (1971) poet. Continue on through to <u>Plaza Sotomayor</u>, the <u>National Navy</u> <u>Building</u>, and the <u>Monument to the Heroes of the Iquique Pacific War</u>.

Ascend the <u>Concepción Hill</u> and stroll along the <u>Atkinson and Gervosani Walks</u> for a beautiful view of the city and the port. Pass by the <u>Baburizza Palace</u>, eventually making your way down to the "<u>El Amendral</u>" Quarter, where you bid farewell to Valparaíso before returning to Santiago.

#### Day 5 SANTIAGO – BUENOS AIRES

Morning Breakfast at Hotel.

Check out of hotel and transfer to the airport for your flight to Argentina.

Arrive at Buenos Aires' Ezeiza International Airport. Check in to your Hotel.

#### Afternoon <u>City Sightseeing Tour</u>







Three-hour city sightseeing tour on your comfortable motorcoach giving you an overview of Buenos Aires' culture and history as seen through its neighborhoods and historical landmarks.

Included highlights are the <u>Casa Rosada</u> (presidential palace), <u>Palace of Congress</u>, the world-class <u>Teatro Colón</u> opera house, <u>Avenida Nueve de Julio</u>, a ten-lane wide avenue with an esplanade in between, and the <u>Obelisk</u> (reminiscent of the Washington Monument).

Continue on to the delightful neighborhoods of <u>La Boca</u>, <u>San Telmo</u>, birthplace of the Tango, <u>Palermo</u>, with wide boulevards, leafy parks, and extravagant monuments, and <u>Recoleta</u>, highlighted by the cemetery featuring opulent mausoleums where "Evita" Perón is buried. After completing your tour, you will understand why Buenos Aires is often compared with Paris and Madrid.

Evening Dinner on your own.

### Day 6 <u>BUENOS AIRES</u>

Free time **<u>suggestion</u>**: Those with an interest in art and culture should visit:







<u>Museo Nacional de Bellas Artes</u> (Museum of Fine Arts) - Buenos Aires' fine arts museum features works of international renown, including several sculptures by Rodin.

<u>Museo Nacional de Arte Decorativo</u> – This former mansion of Buenos Aires' early 20<sup>th</sup> century elite is a wonderful place to visit featuring its own café for a relaxing break.

<u>Museo de Arte Latinoamericano de Buenos Aires</u> (MALBA) – This museum is Buenos Aires' most acclaimed and popular museum with its modern architecture and extensive collection of mostly modern Latin American Art.

Evening Dinner on your own.

## Day 7 <u>BUENOS AIRES</u>

Morning & Afternoon

#### <u>Tigre River Delta – Full-Day Tour</u>







Depart to the <u>Tigre River Delta</u>, about 20 miles north of Buenos Aires, on your private motorcoach.

Arrive in Tigre and board your comfortable boat for a leisurely 45-minute cruise through the islands of this unusual natural river delta. Tigre was once the summer retreat of Buenos Aires' elite with several landmark structures from that elegant era still surviving.

Lunch included at a restaurant.

Morning & **Suggestion**: Great day for shopping! Afternoon







On weekends venture to the **Recoleta Flea Market** for lots of bargains on hand-made leather and other goods at one of the hundreds of stalls staffed by the artisans themselves. On other days, visit the **Galerias Pacífico** shopping center and food court. This is a beautifully-restored early 20th-century landmark that used to be the headquarters offices of the Pacific Railways, but that was recently converted into shops and cafés. Be sure and try some of the delicious cake that is a blend of chocolate and dulce de leche (caramel-type dessert)!

Evening Dinner at a restaurant near your hotel (included in tour program).

Day 9 <u>BUENOS AIRES</u>

Morning & "Pampas" Ranch Day – Full-Day Tour
Afternoon







Depart in your private motorcoach for an exciting visit to an authentic Argentine "estancia" (cattle ranch). Enjoy a 20-minute horse-back riding upon arrival. You can also ride on horse-driven carts. The highlight of your visit is a traditional Argentine "asado" (barbecue) featuring delicious cuts of world-famous Argentine beef grilled over an open pit, followed by a folklore dancing and singing show.

Transfer by your private motorcoach to Ezeiza International Airport for your return flight home.

Evening Relax and sleep during your overnight flight. Dinner and breakfast served aloft.
