ALL FIELD HOCKEY ACTIVITIES ARE HIGHLIGHTED IN RED.

<u>USA – BUENOS AIRES</u> Day 1

Fly overnight to Buenos Aires via major international scheduled airline with possible change of plane enroute. Dinner and breakfast served aloft.

Day 2 **BUENOS AIRES**

Morning Arrive at Buenos Aires' Ezeiza International Airport.

City Sightseeing Tour Morning







Three-hour city sightseeing tour on your comfortable motorcoach giving you an overview of Buenos Aires' culture and history as seen through its neighborhoods and historical landmarks.

Included highlights are the **Casa Rosada** (presidential palace), **Palace of Congress**, the

world-class <u>Teatro Colón</u> opera house, <u>Avenida Nueve de Julio</u>, a ten-lane wide avenue with an esplanade in between, and the <u>Obelisk</u> (reminiscent of the Washington Monument).

Continue on to the delightful neighborhoods of <u>La Boca</u>, <u>San Telmo</u>, birthplace of the Tango, <u>Palermo</u>, with wide boulevards, leafy parks, and extravagant monuments, and <u>Recoleta</u>, highlighted by the cemetery featuring opulent mausoleums where "Evita" Perón is buried. After completing your tour, you will understand why Buenos Aires is often compared with Paris and Madrid.

Afternoon City Tour ends at your Three-Star Hotel where you will check-in.

Afternoon "Primera A" Women's Club Game – Watch some of the world's top hockey!!! (subject to availability)

Evening <u>Welcome Dinner</u> at a typical Argentine barbecue restaurant with the best beef you will ever eat! (chicken and vegetarian options available). This dinner is included in your tour package.

Day 3 BUENOS AIRES

Morning PRACTICE SESSION at an astroturf field to warm up for the next few days.

Afternoon **Suggestion**: Great day for shopping!







On weekends venture to the **Recoleta Flea Market** for lots of bargains on hand-made leather and other goods at one of the hundreds of stalls staffed by the artisans themselves. On other days, visit the **Galerias Pacífico** shopping center and food court. This is a beautifully-restored early 20th-century landmark that used to be the headquarters offices of the Pacific Railways, but that was recently converted into shops and cafés. Be sure and try some of the delicious cake that is a blend of chocolate and dulce de leche (caramel-type dessert)!

"Pampas" Ranch Day - Full-Day Tour







Depart in your private motorcoach for an exciting visit to an authentic Argentine "estancia" (cattle ranch). Experience the life of the "gauchos" (cowboys) through roping demonstrations, rides on horse-driven carts plus folklore dancing and singing. Highlight of your visit is a traditional Argentine "asado" (barbecue) featuring delicious cuts of world-famous Argentine beef grilled over an open pit.

Evening <u>Suggestion</u>: Visit **Las Cañitas** neighborhood, one of the nicest districts in the city, famous for its many restaurants, bars, pubs and nightlife.

Training with a **Top-Level Argentine Coach** with **National Team** credentials, such as:

<u>Claudio "Lalo" Junquet</u> – Longtime member of the <u>Argentine National Women's Team</u> coaching staff, "Lalo" is the hockey director at the prestigious <u>Club Atlético San Isidro</u> (CASI) with 30 Girls/Women's Teams under his direction.

<u>Santiago Capurro</u> – Played on the <u>Argentine Men's National Team</u> from 1993-2006 and has coached at all levels, including the <u>Argentine Women's National Team</u>.

<u>Mariana "Donna Rossi</u> – Current member of "Las Leonas" <u>Argentine Women's</u> <u>National Team</u> that won the Champions Trophy in three consecutive years – 2008, 2009, and 2010 plus the Bronze Medal at the 2008 Beijing Summer Olympics.

<u>Rodolfo Schmidt</u> – Argentine Men's National Team goalkeeper at the 1996 Atlanta Summer Olympics.

Afternoon **Suggestion:** Those with an interest in art and culture should visit:







<u>Museo Nacional de Bellas Artes</u> (Museum of Fine Arts) - Buenos Aires' fine arts museum features works of international renown, including several sculptures by Rodin.

<u>Museo Nacional de Arte Decorativo</u> – This former mansion of Buenos Aires' early 20th century elite is a wonderful place to visit featuring its own café for a relaxing break.

<u>Museo de Arte Latinoamericano de Buenos Aires</u> (MALBA) – This museum is Buenos Aires' most acclaimed and popular museum with its modern architecture and extensive collection of mostly modern Latin American Art.

<u>Tigre River Delta – Full-Day Tour</u>







Depart to the **Tigre River Delta**, about 20 miles north of Buenos Aires.

Arrive in Tigre and board your comfortable boat for a leisurely 45-minute cruise through the islands of this unusual natural river delta. Tigre was once the summer retreat of Buenos Aires' elite with several landmark structures from that elegant era still surviving.

Free time for lunch on your own and shopping in the **Mercado de Frutos**.

Evening Dinner at your hotel or nearby restaurant (included in tour program).

Day 7 <u>BUENOS AIRES – MONTEVIDEO</u>

Morning Breakfast at Hotel.

Check out of Hotel and transfer to the Buenos Aires port passenger terminal.

Check in for your **Buquebus** cruise to Montevideo, Uruguay.

Late Morning Arrival in Montevideo. Transfer to your Three-Star Hotel for check-in. Lunch on your own.

Plaza Independencia



Presidents' Museum

Board your private motorcoach for a full-afternoon tour of Montevideo's historic and present-day sights with your bilingual guide.

View the <u>Ciudad Vieja</u> (the "Old City" founded in colonial times) and the <u>Metropolitan</u> <u>Cathedral</u>. <u>Plaza Independencia</u>, the square in the heart of the city, features a lovely plaza and monument to General Artigas (Uruguay's George Washington) and is overlooked by <u>Palacio Salvo</u> (Uruguay's' first skyscraper).

Continue on to **Avenida 18 de Julio**, the city's main thoroughfare and shopping street. Following this part of town, view the imposing **Parliament Building**, "**La Carreta**" monument to Uruguay's settlers and the 73,000-seat **Estadio Centenario**, site of the first World Cup of Soccer in 1930.

A hidden gem is the <u>Museum of the Uruguayan Presidency</u>, a small but complete museum that tells the story of this interesting country in a nutshell.
