PLEASE NOTE: Actual sequence and timing of activities will revolve around your game & practice schedule, which will be finalized in the weeks prior to your team's arrival at its destination. All times are approximate and may vary according to flight schedules and other logistical factors.

ALL SPORTS ACTIVITIES ARE HIGHLIGHTED IN RED.

Day 1 USA – BUENOS AIRES

Fly overnight to Buenos Aires via major international scheduled airline with possible change of plane enroute. Dinner and breakfast served aloft.

Day 2 BUENOS AIRES

Morning Arrive at Buenos Aires' Ezeiza International Airport.

Greeting by your highly-qualified **Tour Manager**. The Tour Managers we select are chosen for their high-energy and commitment to customer satisfaction. For the duration of your stay, your Tour Manager will be coordinating and managing all of your scheduled activities and will be available to you on a 24-hour basis should you need special assistance.

Morning City Sightseeing Tour



Three-hour city sightseeing tour on your comfortable motorcoach giving you an overview of Buenos Aires' culture and history as seen through its neighborhoods and historical landmarks.

Included highlights are the <u>Casa Rosada</u> (presidential palace), <u>Palace of Congress</u>, the world-class <u>Teatro Colón</u> opera house, <u>Avenida Nueve de Julio</u>, a ten-lane wide avenue with an esplanade in between, and the <u>Obelisk</u> (reminiscent of the Washington Monument).

Continue on to the delightful neighborhoods of **La Boca**, **San Telmo**, birthplace of the Tango, **Palermo**, with wide boulevards, leafy parks, and extravagant monuments, and **Recoleta**, highlighted by the cemetery featuring opulent mausoleums where "Evita" Peron is buried. After completing your tour, you will understand why Buenos Aires is often compared with Paris and Madrid.

Afternoon City Tour ends at your Three-Star Hotel where you will check-in.

Suggestion: Explore **Santa Fe Avenue** featuring many shops and sidewalk cafes for lunch on your own. Choose one of the informal "parilla" grill restaurants for a delicious beef or chicken barbecue lunch or lighter fare at another eatery.

Evening **Welcome Dinner** at a typical Argentine barbecue restaurant with the best beef you will ever eat ! (chicken and vegetarian options available). This dinner is included in your tour package.

Highlight of your visit is a traditional Argentine "asado" (barbecue) featuring delicious cuts of world-famous Argentine beef grilled over an open pit.

Evening **Suggestion**: Visit **Las Cañitas** neighborhood, one of the nicest districts in the city, famous for its many restaurants, bars, pubs and nightlife.

Palacio Salvo

Presidents' Museum

Board your private motorcoach for a full-afternoon tour of Montevideo's historic and presentday sights with your bilingual guide.

Plaza Independencia

View the <u>**Ciudad Vieja</u>** (the "Old City" founded in colonial times) and the <u>**Metropolitan**</u> <u>**Cathedral**</u>. <u>**Plaza Independencia**</u>, the square in the heart of the city, features a lovely plaza and monument to General Artigas (Uruguay's George Washington) and is overlooked by <u>**Palacio Salvo**</u> (Uruguay's' first skyscraper).</u>

Continue on to **Avenida 18 de Julio**, the city's main thoroughfare and shopping street. Following this part of town, view the imposing **Parliament Building**, "**La Carreta**" monument to Uruguay's settlers and the 73,000-seat **Estadio Centenario**, site of the first World Cup of Soccer in 1930. Evening Dinner at your hotel or nearby restaurant (included in tour program).

Day 8 MONTEVIDEO – RIO DE JANEIRO

Morning Transfer to Montevideo's Carrasco International Airport for your flight to Rio de Janeiro.

Afternoon Arrive at Rio de Janeiro's Galeão International Airport.

Transfer to your Three-Star Hotel on or near Rio de Janeiro's famous **Copacabana Beach** where you will check in.

Afternoon Lunch at a restaurant near your hotel on your own.



Head to the beach, take a dip in the warm ocean waters, join in or watch a game of *futevolei*, a Brazilian invention that mixes beach soccer and volleyball. The beaches are lined with pick-up games, or with people simply juggling a loose ball around in a circle. Don't forget to try the **Globo** cookies that they sell on the beach! Or just take in the "sights" !

Suggestion: Try the fresh "sucos" (squeezed juice) at every corner! Açaí (a purplish fruit from the Amazon) is a local delicacy that many "cariocas" (Brazilians from Rio) cannot live without !

Morning Corcovado Mountain & Christ Redeemer Statue

Arrive at the Cosme Velho train station at the base of the Corcovado Mountain where you will board the cog railway train for the ascent to the summit where the impressive 125-foot high Christ statue overlooks the city. Completed in 1931, the art deco statue can be seen from most of Rio de Janeiro. The mountain is located behind most of the city and affords magnificent panoramic views of the **Copacabana** and **Ipanema Beaches**, **Sugarloaf Mountain**, Rio's **Historic Center** and **Guanabara Bay**, orienting you to all of the city's major attractions.

Afternoon Sugarloaf Mountain excursion

Take the two-stage cable car for the nearly mile-long ascent to the 1,299-foot-high summit of the mountain for one of the world's most spectacular views with great vistas of the surrounding bays, beaches, mountains and the city itself. Optional visit to the restaurant and shops at the first cable car stop - the 700-foot-high **Morro de Urca**. Don't forget your camera !

Rio de Janeiro is famous for its intra-city professional team rivalries. There are four professional teams in Rio, leading to constant excitement and soccer passion !!! <u>Flamengo</u> vs. <u>Fluminense</u> – known as <u>FlaFlu</u>, has been a bitter rivalry since the early 1910s. <u>Vasco de Gama</u> and <u>Botafogo</u> are also fervent competitors ! (subject to availability and being in-season).

Evening Return back to your hotel and enjoy your last night in Rio! Visit the restaurants and clubs lining **Rua General San Martin**. Hotspots line this street, a block from the beach in **Lebion**, a trendy neighborhood next to **Ipanema**!
