- **Fussen** – Visit this charming town of 15,000 dating back to Roman times and dominated by Bavarian-style architecture featuring heavy timber structures, A-frame roofs and ornate shutters.

- **Viktualienmarkt** - Large food market with pubs, beer halls, and restaurants.
