Ancient Rome Half-Day Tour (admission included)

The juxtaposition between Rome's ancient landmarks and monuments beside its modern buildings and other structures makes for a fascinating contrast between old and new.

- **Coliseum** – One of the world's most iconic and recognizable ancient buildings, this structure was completed in 80 AD as a site for fights between gladiators and other events.
- **Palatine Hill** – The most famous of Rome's "Seven Hills." This was also a site for the earliest Roman settlements.
- **Roman Forum** – A plaza that was the center of Roman public life for centuries.
- **"Via Sacra"** – Also known as the "Sacred Way," this was the main street of ancient Rome and led to the Forum.

- **St. Peter's Basilica** – The world's largest Christian Church and burial place of many popes.
- **Pietà** – Michelangelo's famous sculpture of Jesus on the lap of his mother Mary after the crucifixion.

- **Cathedral (Duomo)** – Dating back to the 15th century with its massive "Cupola del Brunelleschi," possibly the largest dome ever built, and its bell tower.
- **Ponte Vecchio** – Admire the arched stone bridge, which has spanned the **Arno River** since the 14th century.

- **“Romeo & Juliet”**– Known for the setting of Shakespeare’s play, view the balcony said to be where the famous scene between Romeo and Juliet played out.
- **Verona Coliseum** – Smaller than Rome’s but still impressive and used even today for musical and other events. (optional - admission approx. US\$ 12)
- **Castelvecchio** (Old Castle) – Built in the 14th century, this castle-fortress is also an art museum. (optional – admission approx. US\$ 12)

Lunch on your own in one of the cafés or restaurants on **Plaza Bra** adjacent to the Coliseum. Arrive in Padua and check in to your Three-Star hotel.

Transfer to Venice for a full-day touring this legendary city.

Grand Canal

- **Piazza San Marco** – An iconic square watched over by St. Mark’s Basilica, a masterpiece of Byzantine architecture.
- **Campo Santa Maria Formosa** – One of Venice’s largest squares bordered by small shops and residential areas.
- **Cannaregio** – A small district filled with local shops and restaurants, also home to the Church of San Giovanni de Paolo.

Lunch on your own in one of Venice's many eateries.

Free time to explore this city’s many quaint alleyways and hidden charms.

Grand Canal Boat Tour (boat ticket included)



Enjoy a one-hour boat ride in a traditional gondola along the **Grand Canal**, Venice's main "street" ! Admire the city from a different point of view. Palaces, churches, and picturesque and charming houses, shops, and other structures make for a fairy tale landscape taking you back to another time. Continue your ride through some of the smaller canals to discover the soul and intimate feel of this wonderful place. (boat ticket included)
