Toledo – Full-Day Tour

Bridge over Río Tajo

Travel one hour to the fascinating ancient walled city of **Toledo**, dating back some 2,000 years. Perched high on a hill overlooking the **Río Tajo**, the city is like an open-air museum holding some of Spain's most important landmarks.

- **Alcázar** – Imposing Muslim-era stone fortification prominently overlooking the city.
- **Catedral de Toledo** – Considered the top example of the Gothic architectural style in Spain.
- **“El Greco Trail”** – Landmarks with *El Greco* works, including the Museo de El Greco and Iglesia de Santo Tomé, featuring the artist's masterpiece, *El Entierro del Conde de Orgaz*
- **Jewish Quarter** – Visit the Sinagoga del Transito and the Museo Sefardi for a glimpse into the history of Jewish culture in Spain.
- **Plaza de Zocodover** – Popular gathering place to enjoy lunch and people-watching.

Royal Palace of Madrid (admission included)



Visit this marvelous palace, a massive Italianate Baroque structure built in the 18th century with 2,800 rooms, fifty of which are included in the official tour. View ornately decorated, gold-gilded rooms featuring high ceilings, glittering chandeliers and vibrant frescoes.

- **Grand Stairway** – Imposing staircase constructed from one giant piece of marble
- **Royal Armory** – Extensive collection of weapons and body armor from wars of past centuries

- **Crown Room** – Featuring Spanish King Charles III’s throne, scepter and crown with grandeur straight out of Hollywood !

Segovia

Travel to this Roman city, located some 50 miles from Madrid.

- **Roman Aqueduct** – Stunning structure dating back to the 1st-century that carried water some 9.3 miles from the Rio Frio river to the city
- **Alcázar** – Islamic-era castle with fairy tale Rapunzel towers topped with witches’ hats
- **Cathedral** – Gothic-style church built in the 17-century with an imposing 300-foot-tall tower

Ávila

Continue on to this nearby fortified city that was originally built in 1090

- **City Walls** – Walk along the well-preserved medieval wall that is 1.5 miles long surrounding the city and featuring 88 round defensive towers with battlements at the top
- **Old Town** – Navigate the narrow streets and little squares of the Old Town and enjoy “tapas” (variety of appetizers) and a drink at one of the many local establishments

EL ESCORIAL

El Escorial Monastery – Half-Day Tour (admission included)



This huge complex, built in the 16th century, serves as a monastery, basilica, royal palace, pantheon, library, and university, and is the largest Renaissance building in the world.

Important sections:

- **Basilica** – Ranking with Europe’s most impressive cathedrals, points of interest include the vaults with eight frescoes by Luca Giordano, the 100-foot-high altarpiece of the main chapel, the large Sacristy with paintings by Titian and El Greco plus the carillon and four large organs.
- **Palace of Philip II** – A series of decorated room with a view to the basilica.
- **Hall of Kings** – Fresco battles depicting the most important Spanish military victories.
