IMPORTANT: The dates and times of the activities below will likely be adjusted to accommodate your game schedules, which will be finalized in the weeks prior to your team's arrival at its destination. All times are approximate and may vary according to flight schedules and other logistical factors.

ALL FIELD HOCKEY ACTIVITIES ARE HIGHLIGHTED IN RED.

Day 1 **USA – FLIGHTS**

Fly overnight to Amsterdam. Possible change of plane enroute. Dinner and breakfast served aloft.

Day 2 **AMSTELVEEN**

Arrive at Amsterdam's Schiphol Airport.

Greeting by your Tour Manager.

Transfer by private motorcoach to Amstelveen, just south of Amsterdam,

Check into your Three-Star Hotel, near the "Amsterdamse Bos" (Amsterdam Forest) Hockey Clubs.

Hockey Clubs - AH&BC + Pinoké + Hurley

You will spend the next few days in the complex which is home to three of the Netherlands' most famous hockey clubs; **Amsterdamsche Hockey & Bandy Club (AH&BC)**, **Pinoké** and **Hurley**, commonly referred to as the "**Bosclubs**" (Forest Clubs), located just south of Amsterdam.

These three clubs have 13 Astroturf hockey fields between them and the complex is home to **Wagener Stadium**, the **7,600-seat facility** which serves as the Dutch national field hockey stadium and is one of two sites playing host to the 2026 Men's and Women's World Cup of Field Hockey.

PRACTICE SESSION at one of the "Bosclub" fields to warm up for the next few days.

Dinner included at your hotel or local restaurant.

Day 3 **AMSTELVEEN – AMSTERDAM**

Transfer by bikes from your hotel to the hockey club (preferred national mode of transportation)

FIELD HOCKEY CLINIC #1 – AH&BC / Pinoké / Hurley Clubs

The clinics, to be led by highly-qualified professional Dutch coaches, will take place at one or more of these prestigious and accomplished clubs (according to availability) all located adjacent to each other in Amstelveen.

AH&BC – 4 artificial turf fields (includes Wagener, the national field hockey stadium)

Pinoke – 4 artificial turf pitches

Hurley – 5 artificial turf pitches

Anne Frank House

One of Amsterdam's most compelling attractions, home of the young Jewish girl who kept famous diary entries during World War II while she and her family were hidden from the German forces. **(admission included)**

Transfer by public transportation to Canal Cruise.

Canal Cruise (boat tickets included)



Enjoy a **Boat Tour** of Amsterdam's canals starting from the **Centraal Station** where you will radiate out past many of the city's engaging attractions and charming neighborhoods.

Dinner included at your hotel or local restaurant.

Day 4

AMSTERDAM – VOLENDAM – ZAAANSE SCHANS

(B,D)

Transfer by private motorcoach to Volendam, Zaanse Schans, Stroopwafel-making class and Match #1.

Volendam



Volendam, historically a fishing town, is very popular with visitors for its colorful old wooden houses and quaint fishing boats located on the Markermeer Lake. Locals still dress up in traditional Dutch garb on holiday celebrations, including clogs, aprons and bonnets.

Zaanse Schans Windmills (admission included)



View this collection of eight windmills, perhaps the most iconic symbol of The Netherlands, with some dating back several centuries. Visit some of the small shops and other attractions in this small town.

Stroopwafel-Making Class (optional for a fee)

Learn the history of the Dutch stroopwafel while mixing your own dough, cooking on the iron and filling it with caramel.

Afterclinic lunch at the club.

Transfer by train to Haarlem.



Visit Haarlem, a charming smaller city near Amsterdam with an abundance of canals.

Continue on to nearby **Zandvoort Beach**, located on the North Sea, to sunbathe and walk on its soft sands and swim in its clean water.

Watch the world's top hockey teams to see the game played at its highest level.

HAARLEM – THE HAGUE

Check out of hotel.

Transfer to **The Hague**, home to the Dutch government and important international institutions. Check in to your Three-Star Hotel.

- **Binnenhof & Ridderzaal (Inner Court & Hall of the Knights)** - Courtyard surrounded by the Dutch Prime Minister's Office and the 13th-century Gothic-style Ridderzaal.
- **Peace Palace** - View the magnificent home of the International Court of Justice
- **The Hague Tower** – Go up to the 42nd floor observation deck for panoramic views of the North Sea, Rotterdam, and as far away as Amsterdam. **(optional - approx. US\$ 12)**
- **Skyview De Pier** - Ride this enormous ferris wheel on the Scheveningen Beach for fabulous views of the coast - four times around in 20 minutes. **(optional - approx. US\$ 12)**

Transfer by private motorcoach to hockey club.
